
Lord's Acre Sunday November 24th

SCRIPTURAL HOLINESS SHORT COURSE AT WBS

Want to learn about what John Wesley taught about scriptural holiness? Lay people will have an opportunity for a more in-depth study with Wesley Biblical Seminary professor, Dr. Chris Lohrstorfer, through the popular Wesley Institute platform.

The class will be six sessions offered live via Zoom on






