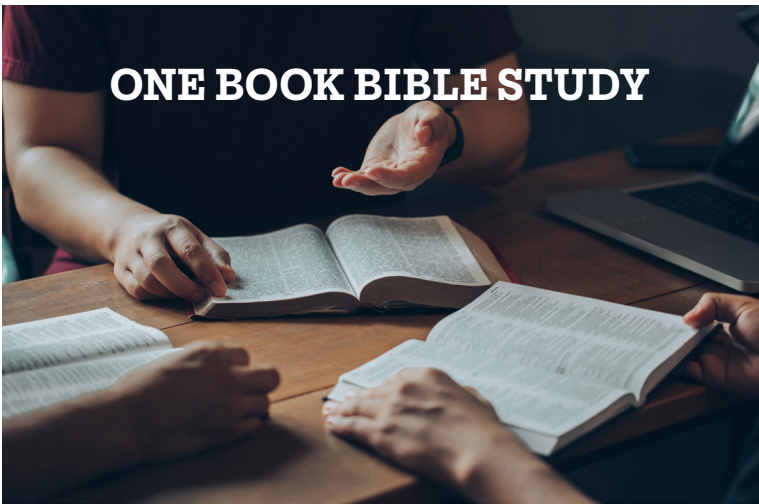

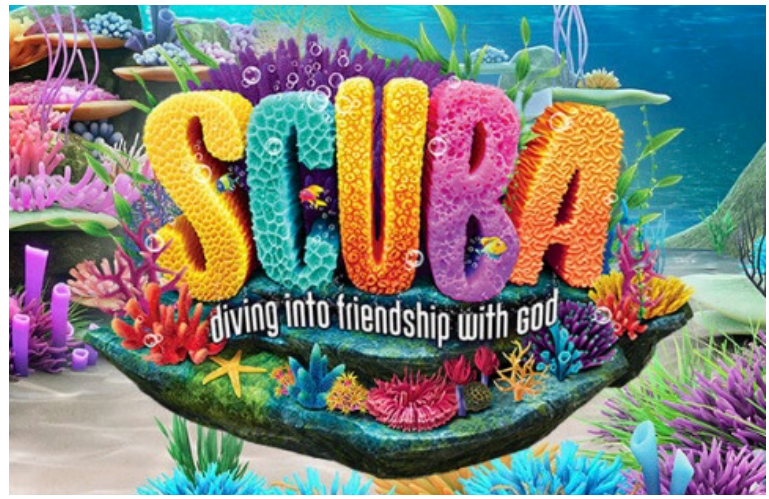

HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

MUMC will participate in building a new house with Habitat for Humanity during June and July. This project is the "Faith Build 2024" because it will again be funded and built as a cooperative effort by the congregations of Methodist, Episcopal, Catholic, Presbyterian, Baptist, and non-denominational churches in the Mississippi Capitol area.

The home is being built for Tiffany Griffin and her 14 year old son and will have three bedrooms and two bathrooms. It will be located at 602 Stonewall Street in Jackson, which is almost across the street from the Habitat Office. Workdays will be on Saturday of each week beginning June 1 and continuing to completion on July 27.

Madison Methodist will have a dedicated day on June 8, when we will be completing the walls by installing sheathing, top plates, and plumbing the walls in preparation to installing roof trusses. In addition, volunteers can sign up to work on any Saturday using the following sign up application that indicates the planned work tasks for each day and number of volunteers. Please consider signing up for multiple days if the tasks are what you feel most comfortable working on. Since we will again be building a brand new house from the ground up, this should be a fun and fulfilling project.
