Global Methodist General Conference Recap:

The Global Methodist Church held our Convening General Conference in San Jose, Costa Rica, September 20-26. The delegation from the Mississippi-West Tennessee Annual Conference included our own Andy Miller, III, and Jim Genesse. It was an incredible time of worship and lowship as hundreds of

people gathered from around the world, representing over 30 countries. There was a wonderful sense of unity and purpose, all strengthened by the tangible presence of the Holy Spirit. As part of the official organization of the denomination a mission statement was adopted which states: "The Glob-

Methodist Church exists to make disciples of Jesus Christ and spread scriptural holiness across the globe."

Bishops Scott Jones and Mark Webb were formally elected to the GMC episcopacy, along with six new interim part-time bishops were elected to serve until 2026. They are: Kimba Everiste (Democratic Republic of the Congo); Carolyn Moore (North Georgia); Leah Hidde-Gregory (Mid Texas); John Pena Auta (Nigeria); Kenneth Levingston (Trinity); and Jeff Greenway (Allegheny West).

Legislative work provided for a lean and nimble organization in areas such as clergy education, and financial stewardship. New churches and new Annual Conferences around the world are

continuing to align with the Global Methodist Church and planning is underway for the 2026 General Conference to be held in central Africa. We rejoice in what God is doing through the GMC and are excited to be part of this new Methodist movement.

Staff Parish Relations Committee update:

The Staff Parish Relations Committee has begun the hiring process for our Student Ministry position. Here are a few updates about that.

- 1. Rev. Cory Phillips will remain on our staff through the month of October. We will have a reception for him and his family on the morning of Sunday, October 27. We will share more details about that event in our next newsletter, through our social media, and on our website.
- 2. We are pleased to report that our Ministry Associate, David Torrent, and our Student Intern, Allie King, have committed to remain on our staff through at least the school year to help us through this transition!
- 3. Members from our Staff Parish Relations Committee had a wonderful meeting with our Student Ministry Team recently to hear their thoughts, hopes, and concerns about this process and the Student Minister position. We have a great team of student and adults leading that team!
- 4. We are beginning initial interviews with multiple candidates soon. Most churches find that the hiring process for a Student Minister takes many months, and we are committed to taking the time we need to find who God has for our students and for our church family.
- 5. Please contact Rhonda Boles, SPRC chairperson, and our pastors with any questions or concerns.
- 6. Most importantly, let's all be praying for God to open the door for the right person to lead our Student Ministry.
